In this call for contributions, the “Best Practices in Jesuit Higher Education Project”, in collaboration with the IAJU Task Force on Peace and Reconciliation, announces its fourth issue, which focuses on **Research and Advocacy in the area of Reconciliation and Peace at Jesuit universities and Higher Education Institutions.**

The “Best Practices in Jesuit Higher Education Project” is a global initiative of the International Association of Jesuit Universities (IAJU). It shares experiences, best practices, and know-how from our institutions. It promotes academic collaboration, encourages shared reflection, and identifies strategic goals.

We invite you to contribute to this issue in an article or a video clip. Out of the proposed contributions and articles, best practices will be selected and published on the IAJU website, in social media, newsletters, infographics, and in the project’s magazine. Regional Networks will disseminate these practices through their own media and communication channels. Following the publication in the project’s magazine and collaboration with the IAJU Task Force on Peace and Reconciliation, a series of webinars will be organised with selected authors to foster communication and networking among the Ignatian community worldwide.

Contributions can be written articles (1500 words) or videos (12 minutes). A written abstract text (200 words) is always required, and, in the case of a video contribution, a written summary (500 words) containing, where needed, well-defined hyperlinks. Please consult the guidelines for the submission of contributions. Faculty members, administrators, staff of Jesuit institutions and students are invited to participate. Through the IAJU international network, we can learn from and collaborate with one another. English, Spanish, or French manuscripts and videos are welcome.
